WHY THIS INFORMATION

Processable personal data

Personal Data: any information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person ("**data subject"**); an identifiable natural person is one who can be identified, directly or indirectly, in particular by reference to an identifier such as a name, an identification number, location data, an online identifier or to one or more factors specific to the physical, physiological, genetic, mental, economic, cultural or social identity of that natural person (Recital 26, 27, 30 GDPR).

Navigation data

Computer systems and software procedures used to the operation of this website acquire, during their normal operation, some personal data whose transmission is implicit in the internet communication protocols. This information is not collected to be associated with identified data subject, but by their nature could, through processing and association with data held by third parties, allow users to be identified. 5. EXISTENCE OF AUTOMATED PROCESS

6. DATA SUBJECT'S RIGHTS

In the cases provided for, you have the right to the portability of your data (art. 20) and in this case the Data Controller will provide you with a structured, commonly used, and readable form of your personal data electronically. In addition, you have the right to object (art. 21), at any time, to the processing of your data. In particular you have the right to object at any time with reference to the communications indicated in purpose B and you will no longer receive such communications. You have the right to withdrawal your consent without affecting the lawfulness of the processing based on the consent before withdrawal.
